INSTRUCTIONS**


Please maintain physical distance of at least 6 ft. from the person in front of you when you come forward to collect your Communion cup, and remember to sanitize your hands first.

Family groups may come forward together. Parents, please assist children by taking a cup for them. Bring your Communion cup back to your pew with you. Once everyone has come forward, the priest will direct everyone to consume the bread at the same time.

Though we are only able to receive communion in one kind at this time, our tradition assures us this is acceptable. Reception in one kind confers all the benefits of receiving in both kinds.

****Please do not leave paper cups in the pews.****

The church has a designated receptacle at the door to the church. These will then be collected and disposed of properly and reverently by the priest.

St. Margaret's Church will offer a Compline Service each Friday of Advent, at **8 p.m.**, beginning **Friday, December 4**. Please join us on our Facebook page for this time of reflection, quiet prayer and gentle music. Compline is a wonderful way to give thanks for the blessings of the day and to ask God's protection for us during the night. Paired with the season of Advent, it bids us to *wait on God* — to prepare our hearts for the coming of Jesus at Christmas and in each moment of our everyday lives. Joan Weber will be the officiant for the service.

Education for Ministry

Education for Ministry (EfM) is a four-year, adult formation program for lay ministers. The program is created and administered by the University of the South's School of Theology and is presented in small groups, facilitated by mentors. Participants study scripture, church history, Christian ethics and spirituality.

Through group theological reflection, participants learn to "do" theology and build personal skills used in all types of ministry. New Members join the group at the beginning of the year. At St. Margaret's each year begins in January and members register each year in November.
